Rules

Paint-By-Numbers

The numbers tell how many filled squares are in each row and column. Each number represents a group of filled squares in that particular row or column. There is always at least 1 empty square separating the groups of filled squares. The end-result usually represents a criss-cross.

Train

The train track is a closed loop that visits every square exactly once, only moves horizontally or vertically from one square to the next, visits every station in numerical order (with 1 following 9), and never makes a turn when passing through a station.

Snakes

Six snakes, each ten unshared squares long including head and tails, are wriggling in the grid below. The snakes' bodies can turn any number of times, but they only bend at right angles. In addition to all of their tails, a few other body parts are shown to get you started.
